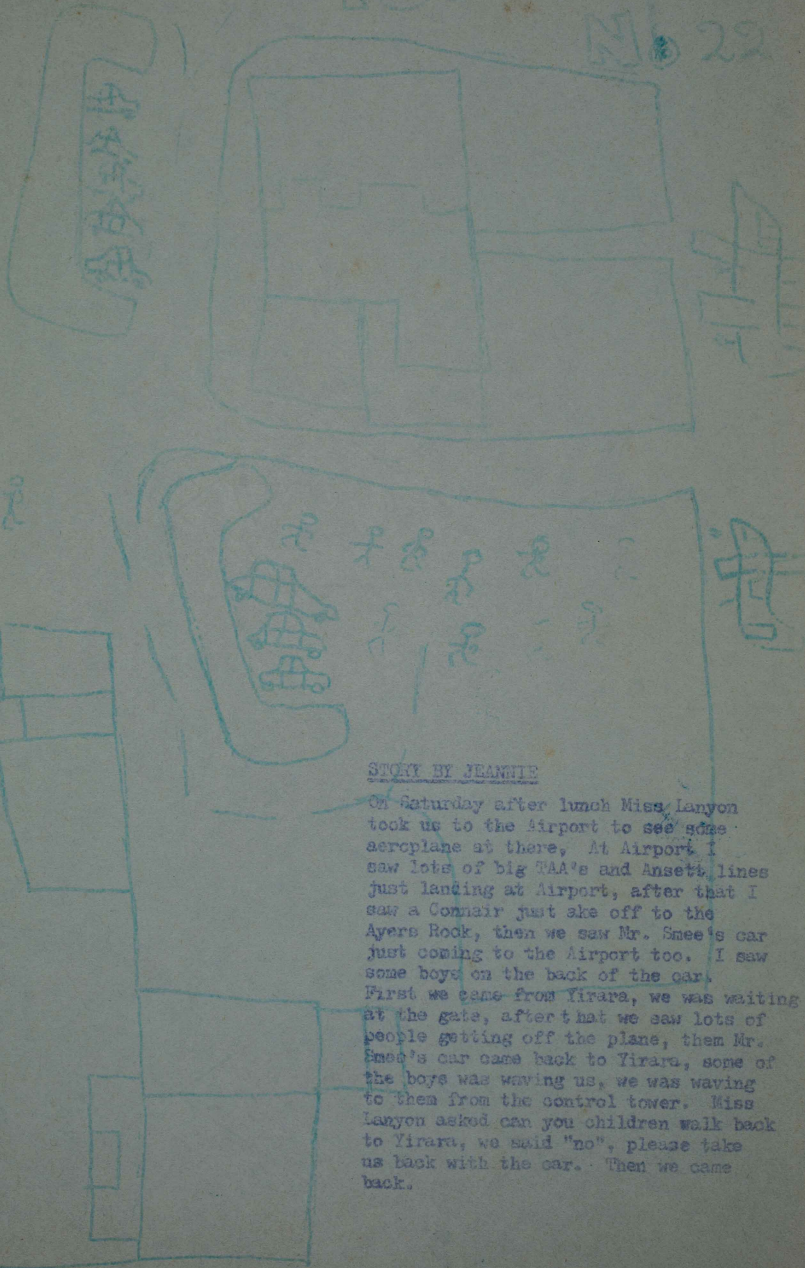


YIRARA No 22
