Santa Teresa

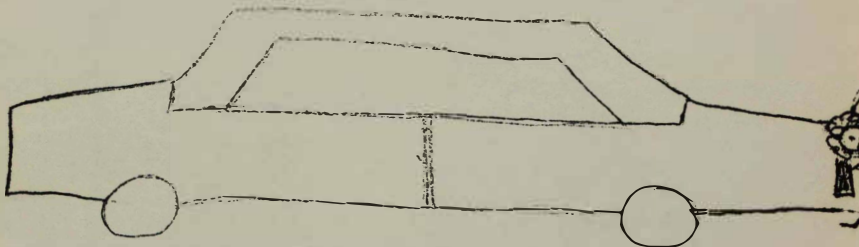
